Photography Tips

Please submit professional photographs if you have them available.

Tips for taking professional looking photographs of your pet.

- Get down to your pet's level.
- Focus on the eyes.
- Avoid busy backgrounds.
- Use natural light.
- Talk to your pet during the shoot.
- Highlight your pet's personality.
- Frame your shot in different ways.
- Avoid shooting directly into the sun.
- If inside, ensure there is enough light.
- Blur the background by using "Portrait Mode."
- Use "Burst mode" – this allows you to take a series of photographs so you can select the best and discard the rest.
- For extra active animals use "Camera Panning."

Uploading and emailing photographs:

- Start with high quality images – should be high resolution appropriate for printing.
- If using a hard copy of a photo, make sure it is professionally scanned or scan it yourself at 300 dpi at full size.
- Use the right file type: JPEG, JPG, or PNG.
- Save the photo at maximum file size.
- Name the image so we can easily identify the pet/owner.
- If sending from a phone do not compress the size – the photo should be at original size.
